Treasurer's Report

- Received donations form St John Summer Reading
- The Library Board of Trustees voted and moved to raise the rates for renting spaces in the Library to \$45 from \$40 per hour and added a recommended donation from Non-Profits of a \$50 flat rate
- Shirley moved to apply for a grant for \$300-\$400 from the Libraries Insurance provider to go towards the Spooktacular
 - Stipulations for the grant
 - Must invite Libarary staff and promote wellness (such as making recipes from their site)
- Shirley is to retire from the Library officially on April 4th
 - She has offered to volunteer her time to the FOL as an accountant with an additional \$100 rate to go towards any filing costs
 - FOL will look into other options efor accounting as well
- The names on the Edward Jones account have been updated
- The Spring CD managed by Umpqua was rolled over for 13 months
