RESOLUTION NO. 2026-08**

A RESOLUTION WAIVING CERTAIN OUTSTANDING FEES AND FINES OLDER THAN SEVEN YEARS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Whitman County Rural Library District is authorized to assess and waive fees and fines; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed outstanding patron balances and determined that fees and fines older than seven (7) years are unlikely to be collected and should be removed from District records;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Whitman County Rural Library District:

1. All outstanding patron fees and fines more than seven (7) years old as of the date of adoption of this Resolution are hereby waived, totaling **\$38,615.12**.
2. The District Director and authorized staff are directed to make the necessary accounting adjustments to remove these balances from District records.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.



**A RESOLUTION REVISING POLICY 5.6 "RULES GOVERNING USE OF THE LIBRARY" TO INCLUDE A
FACE CONCEALMENT POLICY AND A PHONE HARASSMENT POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Whitman County Rural Library District is responsible for establishing and maintaining policies governing the use of District facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, the Board periodically reviews District policies to ensure a safe, welcoming, and orderly environment for patrons and staff; and


WHEREAS, the Board has determined that Policy 5.6, "Rules Governing Use of the Library," should be revised to include provisions addressing face concealment and phone harassment;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Whitman County Rural Library District as follows:


